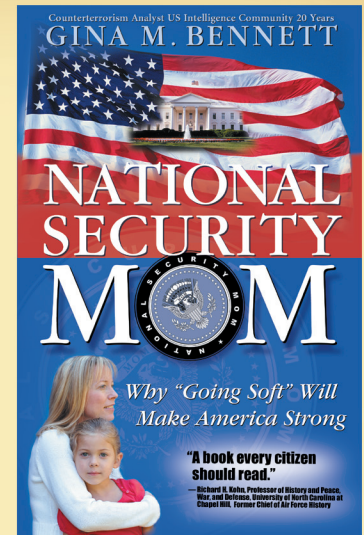


Dear Parents
